THINGS TO DO

- Research and install an anti-virus (AV) program to keep your computer healthy. In your favorite search engine (google, yahoo, etc.) perform a search on "free anti-virus software."
- Run a daily virus scan or use your AV software's scheduling feature to do that for you.
- Do not open attachments in e-mail from **unknown senders**.
- Do not open **unknown attachments** in e-mail from known senders.




ARPIL QUICK FACT
