VACATING ADOPTION OF
INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULES,
Except for RULE 5012

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2005, the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 was enacted into law; and

WHEREAS, on October 13, 2005, by General Order No. 2-06 the judges of this court adopted in their entirety the Interim Rules, which were effective October 17, 2005; and

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2006, the Judicial Conference of the United States approved Amended Interim Rule 1007 which was effective on October 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2006, by Amended General Order No. 2-06, the judges of this court adopted in its entirety Amended Interim Rule 1007; and

WHEREAS, with the exception of Interim Rule 5012, new and amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure will take effect on December 1, 2008;

NOW THEREFORE,


