A party seeking reconsideration of a ruling of a United States Magistrate by a judge of the court, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. Sec. 636(b)(1)(A), shall file a Motion for Reconsideration with the clerk of court within ten (10) days after the ruling, if made in open court, or within ten (10) days after being served with a copy of a written order. Such motion shall enumerate the specific matters which reconsideration is sought, shall of and be accompanied by a supporting brief. brief The in opposition shall be filed within ten (10) days thereafter, and the reply brief, if any, within five (5) days.

A Magistrate may, as a part of the order, provide for a greater or lesser period in which to file the Motion for Reconsideration and may alter the briefing schedule accordingly.
