ORDER

For the purpose of assisting in providing security in the federal courthouses,

It is **ORDERED** that only the United States Marshal, Deputy U.S. Marshals, Court Security Officers, and Federal Protective Service Officers may take a firearm or other weapon into a courtroom or any space occupied by the court in the Western District of Wisconsin. Any other persons bearing or wearing a firearm or weapon shall leave such firearm or weapon in the custody of the United States Marshal while in the courthouse.

Any person intending to use a firearm as an exhibit in court shall have the firearm checked for safety by the United States Marshal before it is taken in a courtroom or its environs.

In the absence of the United States Marshal, the presiding judge may designate a suitable person to take custody of firearms and check the safety of exhibits.

Violation of this order will be treated as a contempt of court.
